

Supplies Required for Winter Cardinal

•Fabric for bird, twigs & leaves

The more variety the better! Pieces don't need to be larger than about an ¼ of a yard. Make sure that you have a good assortment of values for each color. For example, if you have green fabric that you'll be using in your project, collect dark, medium and light green fabrics.

(Fabric bundles are available at CollageQuilter.com)

•1/2 Yard fabric for background & facing

• Lite Steam a Seam 2

Please prepare a good assortment of fabric before class so that we can maximize class time working on our projects. I recommend applying SAS to pieces of fabric that are about 4.5" x 6". Not all fabric will need to be ready to use, but at least enough to begin the project. For help in understanding how to prepare fabric, please check out this free video:

- Parchment paper (baking paper)
 - Fabric scissors
- Fusible Interfacing for Embroidery(Pellon Shape-Flex)
 - Iron (wand iron is preferred)
 - Embroidery thread (optional)
 - •Pins & Pencil
