

## Supply List for Foundation Panel Patterns

•**Fabric** - the more variety the better! Pieces don't need to be larger than about an <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub> of a yard. Make sure that you have a good assortment of values for each color. For example, if you have red fabric that you'll be using in your project, bring dark, medium and light red fabrics. (Fabric bundles are available at CollageQuilter.com)

## •Adhesive of Your Choice

<u>Double-Sided Fusible Web (Lite Steam a Seam 2)</u> If you choose to use this adhesive (which is my preference), please prepare a good assortment of fabric before class so that we can maximize class time working on our projects. I recommend applying SAS to pieces of fabric that are about 4.5" x 6". Not all fabric will need to be ready to use, but at least enough to begin the project. <u>Permanent Fabric Glue</u> (Aleene's Fabric Fusion) <u>Water-Soluble Glue</u> (white tacky glue)

•<u>Fabric scissors</u> (Available for purchase at CollageQuilter.com). I recommend 6" scissors

•<u>1/4</u>" Foam Core Board covered in felt (this is your work surface). Sold at local craft stores, it should be about 20" square (optional)

• Pins & Pencil
