Mandala Mania Freemotion and Rulerwork Exploration

Supply List:

For Road to CA 2023, machines, templates and rulerwork tools will be provided. This list indicates what you would need if you were working at home.

Machine related items

- Your Machine in good working order and your manual
- Rulerfoot to match your machine
- Freemotion darning style foot
 - (I quilt with the ruler foot but this is good to bring)
- Machine Screwdriver
- Straight Stitch Throat Plate
- (May not be suitable for all machines but bring it just in case)

- Appropriate Spool caps
- Prewound bobbins
 - You can purchase or wind these yourself. 60-80 wt neutral thread is recommended such as white or light gray.
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Machine extension table such as a Sew Steady table (HIGHLY recommended)
- Gliders (Freemotion or Rulerwork Gliders)

Please bring the following items with you to class

- 1 Fat Quarter Quilt Sandwiches
 - A good quality batting and fabric is recommended for best results plus a 10" sandwich square to test thread
- Polyester 40wt or 50wt 3 ply thread in a medium contrast to the fabric sandwich. You may bring more than one color.
- Plan to bring or make your own bobbins (Class 15 style)
- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools such as chalco liner and air erase markers for fabric
- Rotary rulers for marking such as a 3" x 18".

Westalee items provided for classroom use

- The Westalee Rulerfoot Starter Foot Set and the Circles on Quilts Templates Sets
- Stable Tape
- Gliders (Freemotion or Rulerwork Gliders)
- Westalee 12" Arc template
- Table Polish

Note:

Marking for this class is very important. Bring a Chalco liner if you have it. I also recommend an air erase marker. The crosshair square is a marking tool that allows for segmenting the circle but it has narrow channels so the marking tools must also be narrow to mark easily.
