


Sit Down Longarm Machines for this class are provided by Pfaff and Moore's Sewing Center.

## Matrix – Full Day Workshop

**Description:** Something within or from which something else originates develops, or takes form. Striking, modern, graphic, let's take the tumbling block to the edge of possibilities. A geometric pieced hexagon block that stitches like a dream using Butterfly Seam technique. Huge 15" x 17" pieced hexagon. It's fast, its quick using the Polygon2 Tool and Butterfly Seam. Final quilt size is your choice.

## **Fabric Requirements:**

- (35) 3" x WOF, assorted fabric
- (6) 5½" x WOF, background (one or assorted)
- 1 yard for edging, border and binding


Special tools: Gyleen's Polygon2 (\$20);

**Instructions:** Pattern (\$10)

## **General supplies:**

Sewing machine with manual (are machines provided?); ¼" foot without edge guide (if possible); (2) thread colors, one for the top and another in the bobbin and that is visible on the wrong side of fabric; seam ripper; thread snips; rotary cutter, ruler and mat; extension cord (if needed); straight pins; finger pressing tool; and batting to use as a design wall (optional).

**Gyleen's thoughts:** This design class can go anywhere you want to go. I used every color in my solids box with



multiple solid "whites". I can see this 3D design stitched with blendables, batik, small prints, grunge for sure, and plaids (why not). Fun, fun, fun.
