# Introductory Rulerwork Class featuring the Westalee Continuum Quilt Supply List

## **Machine Supplies and Materials**

At Road to California 2023, machines, templates, and related tools are provided for this class but here are the items you would need if you were working at home

- Machine in good order and manual
- Rulerfoot to match your machine
- Machine Screwdriver
- Straight Stitch Throat Plate if it fits the machine rulerfoot setup
- Polyester 40wt
- Bobbins

- Appropriate Spool caps including the tiny, special purpose spool cap
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Machine extension table such as a Sew Steady table (HIGHLY recommended)

## **Standard Quilting Supplies (Bring with you)**

Quilt Sandwich Requirements: The Continuum Quilt is designed to be reversible so consider top and bottom fabrics carefully. Fabrics should not be too busy. The blocks are joined together with sashing strips so that is a good place to add color. We will work on 4 blocks in the class as well as basic setup and techniques for rulerwork.

#### Bring the following quilts sandwiches cut to size as indicated:

Block A: 15" x 10"
Block L:13" x 13"
Block I: 16" x 5.5"
Block J: 16" x 8"

- Top and Bottom Quilting matching quilting thread suitable for your quilt sandwiches This is quilt as you go with sashing strips. I recommend using polyester such as Isacord or Floriani 40 thread for best results.
- A 15" quilt sandwich to test-sew and check your tension. Use the same fabric and batting as your main quilt project piece.
- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools such as chalk and air erase markers that will show up on your fabric
- Rotary rulers for marking such as a 3" x 18" and an 8" square or equivalent. These will just be used to mark lines, so no specific size is required
- Westalee Spacing Gauge (This is included in the kit fee.)

### Westalee Design Tool Requirements

#### These tools will be provided for use in class except the Spacing Gauge\*

- 12" Arc template
- Westalee Quilt Class in Bag Kit
- Spacing Gauge\*

- Stable Table
- 6 Point Crosshair (small or large is okay)
- Gliders (Sew Steady has several styles)

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. This class shows just a small piece of what rulers can do. We are doing 4 block designs out of a total of 41 to complete the quilt below. You can take the class as a learning experience or use the blocks as the start of your Continuum.
- 2. This class is suitable for any level but some freemotion experience is helpful.
- 3. Additional tools may be shown in class and available for purchase but are not required for class.
- 4. Both Ruler presser feet and templates are matched to your machine style. For example, a low shank machine will need a low shank template. We will discuss this more in class, but this is important to know at the beginning of the rulerwork learning process.
