

Sewing Machines for this class are provided by Baby lock and Moore's Sewing Center.

The following supply list may state that you need to bring your own sewing machine. **THIS IS NOT CORRECT.** *Please do not bring your own sewing machine to this class.*

Machine Supplies and Materials

At Road to California 2023, machines, templates, and related tools are provided for this class but here are the items you would need if you were working at home

- Machine in good order and manual
- Rulerfoot to match your machine
- Machine Screwdriver
- Straight Stitch Throat Plate if it fits the machine rulerfoot setup
- Polvester 40wt
- Bobbins

- Appropriate Spool caps including the tiny, special purpose spool cap
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Machine extension table such as a Sew Steady table (HIGHLY recommended)

Standard Quilting Supplies

- Quilt Top: Fat Quarter Quilt Sandwich. You can make the quilt block or just mark the block onto a fat quarter quilt sandwich for class. Mini Mad Modern Quilt Block Center Marking for Beginning Rulerwork Sampler. Reminder that if you choose to mark your top and not piece the block, the entire marked block design should be 12" square so each quadrant would measure at 6" square and the "center" square is also a 6" unit.
- A 15" quilt sandwich to test-sew and check your tension. Use the same fabric and batting as your main quilt project piece.
- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools such as chalk and air erase markers that will show up on your fabric.
- Rotary rulers for marking such as a 3" x 18" and an 8" square or equivalent. These will just be used to mark lines, so no specific size is required
- Westalee Spacing Gauge (This is included in the kit fee.)

Westalee Design Tool Requirements: These tools will be provided except the Spacing Gauge*

- 12" Arc template
- Westalee Sampler Set 1
- Spacing Gauge*
- Stable Table

- 8 Point Crosshair (small or large is okay)
- Gliders (Freemotion or Rulerwork Gliders)
- Westalee Stitching Line Disks

NOTES:

- 1. This class shows just a small piece of what rulers can do. It is suitable for any level but some freemotion experience is helpful.
- 2. Additional tools may be shown in class and available for purchase but are not required for class.
- 3. Both Ruler presser feet and templates are matched to your machine style. For example, a low shank machine will need a low shank template. We will discuss this more in class, but this is important to know at the beginning of the rulerwork learning process.
